



27th September – National Boys Youth Choir Our guest speaker this week was District Governor David Anderson. David spoke at length about the various parts of Rotary that are important to him:

Rotary distinguishes itself from other organisations by its great fellowship, networking combined wit the ideal of service enriching the lives of the community.

Membership growth is vital for Rotary: Get your "ask" into gear, and find new vibrant members for your club.

Rotary Foundation is our organisation's own charity. Foundation is an endowment fund, started in 1917 with \$26, Rotary now raises more than \$100 million per year for this fund. Eradication of polio is still Foundation's no. 1 priority - The Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation has pledged \$300 million and Rotary's commitment of \$200 million is almost achieved with \$180 already raised.

September is New Generations month (New Generations is officially now the 5th Avenue of Service). RYLAH, RYPEN and Youth Exchange are popular New Generations projects for Rotary Clubs and the latter is often espoused as the **best thing** our club does. DG David uses a Harry Potter analogy to describe those who participate in Youth Exchange (as wizards) and those who have never experienced it (as muggles).
