DG Visit to Corowa**

Our guest speaker this week was Tony Porta. Tony is the Transport Co-ordinator for Kalianna Enterprises Inc. which is a local (Albury based) organisation dedicated to helping disadvantaged people in our community.

Kalianna started in 1976 helping disabled kids but has evolved into a multi-faceted business consisting of Corporate Services, Business Services, Transport Services, Training Services and Support Services.

Tony is co-ordinator of the Transport Services divisions which has operations in the Albury Shire, Hume Shire and Corowa Shire and covers an area of about 8,000 sq kilometres in NSW using 14 funded vehicles of various sizes. The organisation also depends on the services of many volunteers and estimates that approximately 18,000 hours of unpaid time are provided by the many volunteer workers supporting Kalianna.

They are always in need of volunteers and request that if we know of people able and willing to assist to let him or the local co-ordinator, Barbara Robinson, know about them.
