After high school, she went to the Riverina Advanced College of Education at Wagga on a bonded scholarship. Narelle has taught at 10 schools with the first few being as a relieving teacher with her first permanent appointment being at Bogan Gate. While teaching at Parkes Primary School she met her future husband, Bruce, who was a teacher there. Bruce resigned from teaching to join the R.A.A.F. Several years and two daughters later he left the R.A.A.F. to work on the family farm for a while. The family moved to Lake Albert and then to Corowa where Narelle is the Principal of the Corowa Public School with 284 students and 18 teachers.
