LAST MEETING – Craig gave a very enlightening talk on Uncle Tobys, so interesting in fact that nobody was seen to nod off which according to some is quite unusual. The operation in Wahgunyah is one of 40 factories in the world owned by a partnership between Nestle and General Mills. The site has two production plants – breakfast plant producing 49,000 tonnes per year, and the snack foods plant producing 10,000 tonnes. The storage area can hold approx. 20,000 pallets. On average, 22 trucks loads of product are despatched daily. Over the last 4 years, more than \$70 million has been spent on the Wahgunyah facility. Uncle Tobys is involved with The South Australian Research and Development Institute in the breeding of new oat varieties and with the Qld and Newcastle universities in studies of the health benefits of oats.
